

Long Term Health Care Planning

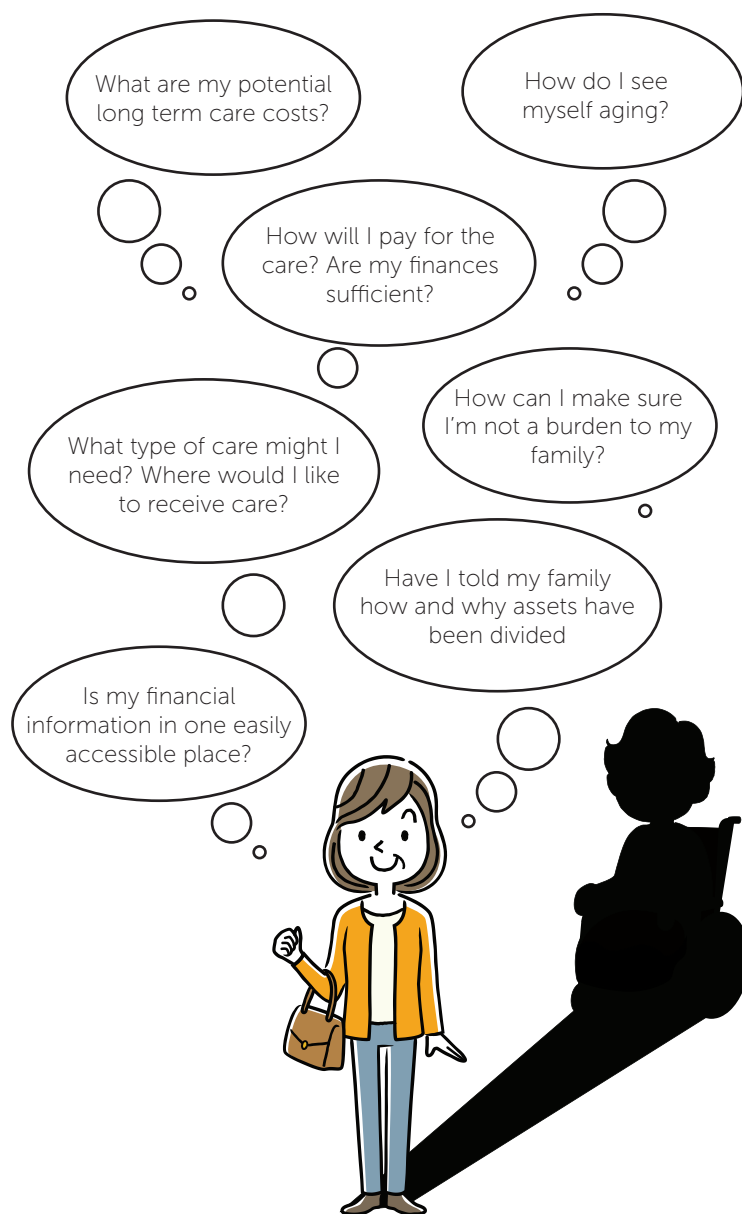
It's never too early to start the care conversation.
