HOBY's flagship program welcomes school and community nominated student ambassadors to 3-4 day seminars each spring and summer. Students explore their personal leadership skills and values, and practice those skills while collaborating with diverse groups. They then leverage their new abilities as they apply the value of service leadership to make a positive impact in their communities. Our State Leadership Seminar curriculum guides student ambassadors as they explore leadership through a three-phase process: personal leadership, group leadership, and service leadership.

## COMMUNITY NOMINATIONS

HOBY's Community Nomination program welcomes HOBY alumni, volunteers, and partner organizations to nominate students for our State Leadership Seminars. Advocates for students who attend virtual and home schools, or students whose schools are unaware of or unable to participate in our programming, are also encouraged to nominate students through this program. Community Nominations help ensure that we continue to achieve our organizational goal of welcoming as many students as possible to this step on their leadership journeys.

Students across the country and around the world attend HOBY seminars, gaining a concrete sense of their own leadership abilities and values, tangible ways to lead diverse groups, and connections with peers across their state.

## HOW TO NOMINATE A STUDENT

1. Visit [hoby.org/programs/state-leadership-seminars](https://hoby.org/programs/state-leadership-seminars)

2. We believe leadership is a skillset to be learned and not a position to be held, so please consider leadership potential when making your selection. We also know that leadership abilities are not defined by gender, race, or socioeconomic status, and we encourage you to consider these factors in your selection.

3. Once you select a student to nominate, you will submit a Community Nomination in our [system](#). You'll include general information about yourself and the student, as well as a brief explanation of why you believe the student is a good fit to attend HOBY.

4. The student will be notified of their nomination. Once their nomination is confirmed, they will receive a confirmation email, and next steps for completing their registration.

5. Be sure to remind your nominee to complete their registration form and if you are able, please consider sponsoring your nominee! The gift of leadership is one of the best investments we can make in our future.
