



Metal Manufacturer Environmental Certification Requirements

- **Complete the first 7 courses 11 hours**
 - Introduction to Environment for Metal Finishing Operations (two courses 3 hrs.)
 - Best Management Practices (5 hr)
 - Metal Finishing BMP
 - Cutting Fluids and Other Issues
 - Solvent waste solutions
 - Lean (and green) Manufacturing (Two courses 3 hrs.)
- Complete 3 elective topics 6-9 hours (variable)
- Have a project plan 8 hours (variable)
