

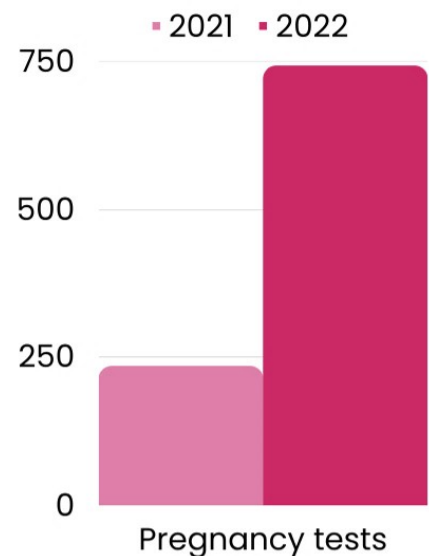
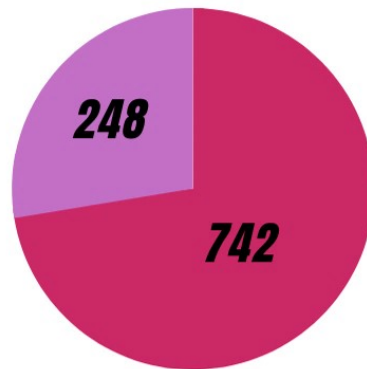

Dear CPC Supporters,

For 42 years, you have generously sustained us in our work to bring hope, truth, and light to pregnant women in our community. Though there is still darkness all around, we know that “the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.” (Jn 1:5) Today, I am pleased to bring you our 2022 Year in Review, which will show you how your support has shone brightly in our community.

You’ve already seen (page 1) the amazing growth we experienced last year, made possible by your generosity. Although we are reporting “980 women” as a statistic, we see each client as an individual with immense dignity who deserves our full attention. In addition to being seen by a client advocate and sonographer, all women served at our downtown medical facility, Options@328, also meet with a registered nurse and are taught about fetal development, tested for high blood pressure, screened for signs of human trafficking, taught how to order and administer a home STD test, connected to post-abortive healing resources, given prenatal vitamins, and offered prayer and a Bible. All for free!

Last year, we upgraded an out-of-date sonogram machine with a new state-of-the-art machine (see below). Our clients have been incredibly impressed and excited by its 3D/4D imaging capabilities when they see their babies on this new machine. The more details they can see, the more unmistakable the child’s humanity and the more powerful the mom’s connection with her little one. Technology makes a big difference in the work we do!

I want to thank each individual, couple, family, pastor, group, business, and church community who supports this ministry. Keep shining your light!

Reversing Medical Abortions

Although already a trend, the reversal of Roe v. Wade has sped up the push to make the two-part abortion pill the new normal. The abortion pill is available online and accounts for *more than half of abortions*.

Options@328 works with women who have changed their minds after taking the first pill in an attempt to halt the process through medical intervention, known as abortion pill reversal (APR). For some, this process proves successful, resulting in a healthy pregnancy. Other women are not so fortunate and suffer greatly as they experience a now-unwanted abortion. There is always a risk of serious emotional trauma. One woman came to us months after her medical abortion, seeking a reprieve from the emotional turmoil she had been experiencing. It was the first time she had left her house in over a year. Thankfully, CPC was able to guide her to a post-abortive healing ministry to begin her recovery.

To date, CPC has been involved in 48 APR phone calls and visits. In 2022, 13 women came to us for our APR services and 13 babies got a second chance at life.

Woman Chooses Life After Sonogram

Last year, "Sally" came to us 20 weeks pregnant. Earlier that week, she had been to an abortion provider and had considered terminating her pregnancy. Our client advocate met with her, listened to her story and heard her fears. Then she received a sonogram and our nurse explained the abortion process at this gestational age, along with its possible side effects. After being equipped with pertinent medical information and community resources, Sally left Options@328 smiling, holding the ultrasound image of her baby. She found prenatal care and delivered a healthy baby boy.

Adoption News

CPC is pleased to inform you that, since Options@328 opened in Fall 2020, two brave women have chosen life by placing their babies with adoptive families. Currently, a third client is considering adoption for her unborn child. Please pray for this brave mother!

Planting Seeds of Life



"Jasmine" was two months pregnant and looking for an abortion. Options@328 staff provided her with a pregnancy test and sonogram and discussed all her options. Jasmine left with life-affirming resources but was still unsure of her next steps. We followed up with calls and texts, but she did not answer.

Finally, at four months pregnant, Jasmine returned to inform us that she had decided to keep her baby. She got another peek at her growing child (see above image) and thanked us for continuing to reach out to her. Jasmine is looking forward to becoming a mother!

Double Blessing

"Emily" came to Options@328 for a pregnancy test that came back positive, but it was too early for her to receive an ultrasound. Two weeks later, Emily returned with her sister and discovered she was having twins!

Check out Dad's face on the cell phone in the picture. He was overcome with emotion when he heard the news!



Prayer Is Essential



Each morning our staff gathers at the start of the workday to pray. We pray for our clients and their families, our supporters and their intentions, our staff and board; for God's protection and strength, for all women considering abortion, and for those who need healing. Finally, we pray for God's blessing and wisdom as we serve women who feel the need to abort their babies.

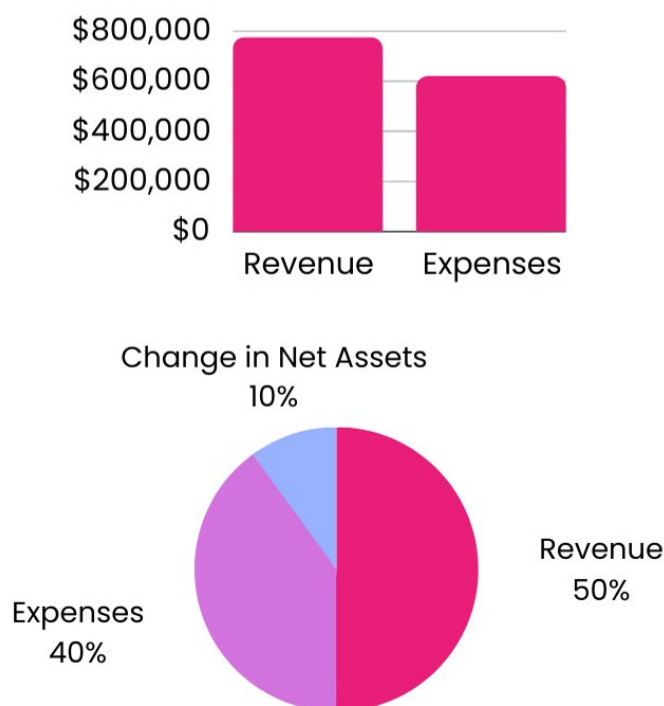

Our Lord has blessed CPC and the women we serve. Through you, our generous donors, He has provided for every expense incurred in 202. We are currently working on a strategic plan to make sure our assets are deployed as effectively as possible to care for even more abortion-vulnerable women in the years ahead.

Last year, we served 300% more women than in 2021. To support this growth, we've budgeted \$820K in revenue this fiscal year. We are planning for growth and to reach more women.
