

### **GREEN TECHNOLOGY**

In 2019, we introduced the world's first hybrid electric-powered expedition cruise ship, MS Roald Amundsen, followed by MS Fridtjof Nansen launching in 2020. By 2021, at least six of our ships will be operating on clean biogas, battery power, and LNG.

### PROTECTING ARCTIC WILDLIFE

Wildlife observation is carried out at a distance to preserve natural behavior and performed with the utmost respect for welfare and habitat.

### **GIVING BACK**

We are dedicated to contributing to the local communities we visit, and to creating a positive impact everywhere we sail. By trading and sourcing services locally, we contribute to the welfare of communities along our routes.

#### PRESERVING OUR WATERS

Hurtigruten actively advocates a ban on polluting, toxic heavy fuel oil (HFO) in all Arctic waters and along the entire Norwegian coast.

Plastic pollution is the biggest single threat to our oceans. We are proud to be the first cruise line in the world to ban all unnecessary single-use plastic.

Did you know that in Antarctica, Hurtigruten ships don't anchor? Instead, 'virtual anchoring' is used, an advanced computer system which controls the location of the ship by maintaining its position without the use of an anchor.
