This collection was transferred to the Mercy Heritage Center, Belmont, North Carolina, in October, 2011.

### **History:**

The Sisters of Mercy came to the Diocese of Toledo from Grand Rapids, Michigan in 1912, at the request of Bishop Joseph Schrembs, who saw a need for healthcare in the Diocese. Sisters Mother Bernardine McMullen and Mother Anthony McMullen arrived in Tiffin, Ohio in 1912 and were later joined by Sister de Chantal and 14 novices. Mercy Hospital, Tiffin opened in 1913. The Sisters immediately began to expand their mission in the Diocese of Toledo, running various schools, a home for working girls and opening Mercy Hospital, Toledo and St. Rita's Hospital, Lima in 1918. Our Lady of the Pines, Fremont, was designated as the Motherhouse for the community in 1926. In 1929 the Sisters voted against joining the Sisters of Mercy of the Union. In 1936, a majority of the Sisters voted to join the Union. The Sisters built or assumed responsibility for other hospitals throughout the region and taught in parish schools at various churches.

### **Scope and Content:**

This collection covers the various ministries of the Sisters of Mercy in the Toledo area, as well the history of the community's membership. The collection is organized by location; series are divided into individual hospitals, convents/residences and parishes/schools throughout northwest Ohio. An additional series, "Membership," contains materials relating to the Sisters of Mercy throughout the Fremont community. Within each series, records are grouped into subseries, such as *Photographs*, *Membership*, *History*, *Financials* and *Newsletters*. These subseries are listed in italics in the Box and Folder List section of this finding aid. Materials located in the Oversize Box are cross-referenced in the appropriate series.
