1. The Museum of Flight Strategic Plan and Partnerships

Matt Hayes presented on the MOF vision for improved partnerships with youth-serving organizations.

- MOF is a Nonprofit organization; 60-person board.
- MOF serves as a research institute with several students who study there under their education program
- It is part of their mission to build a continuum of learning; learn to explore; get inspired; they have courses for college credits and it's free
- They do partner with NASA, Boeing, school districts, etc.
- Multi-generational volunteer structure; About 10 volunteers in their nineties
