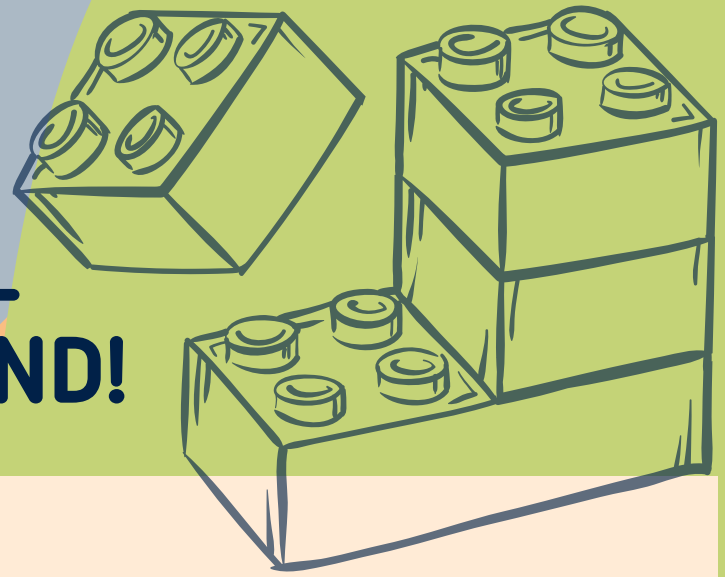


3-4 SESSION PER SCHOOL YEAR

Builders and Makers –

Children engage in social-emotional, fine and gross motor development, and problem solving through playful experiences of building together. Each weekly session involves an opportunity to use a variety of materials to build a collaborative structure based on a story or problem that your child can help solve. Participants practice planning, taking turns, frustration tolerance, compromising, and communicating.

Story Tellers –

Does your child love books and stories? What about performing or creating their own plays and shows? In this class, children are engaged in social-emotional and literacy development through familiar and self-created stories. They get opportunities to practice a wide range of skills such as cooperation, turn taking, problem solving and emotional regulation as well as body movement and verbal language to communicate their thoughts and ideas.
