Flavia is currently the chairperson for Deaf Studies Department.

Dr. Will Garrow is currently an Associate Professor in the Department of Deaf Studies at California State University, Northridge. He earned his degrees at Gallaudet University with a Bachelor of Arts in Deaf Studies, a Master of Arts in Linguistics, and a doctorate in Linguistics.
