Please bring:

- Your camping gear (tents only are allowed at the Group Camp site)
- Food and dishes, etc., for your meals while camping
- Camp chairs and bikes
- Fishing gear
- Something to cook over the campfire and a beverage for yourself for our Saturday Evening Cookout
- Cash: \$10 per person, per night (payable to Kathy Crain at the park). This is a fundraiser for UUFC.

Things to do at and around the park:

- Lake swimming with diving platform at park (included in camping fee)
- Canoe, pedal boat, carpet golf available at park (additional fees)
- Hiking trails, playground, park store/gift shop; geocaching; biking

Planned events:

- Friday (6/11) at 9am: Hike the Oconee Trail
- Friday (6/11) at 8pm: Square Dance to a local bluegrass band in the park barn. This costs \$2/person. This is supposed to be the first weekend of the summer square dance weekend!
- Saturday (6/12) at 9am: Fish and/or Hike at the Burrells Ford. Bring your own fishing gear and license.
- Saturday (6/21) Evening: Cookout. Bring your own meat (or other) to cook over the campfire. Please provide your beverage. We will NOT be doing a potluck this year...
- Sunday Morning Vespers before breaking camp

Driving Directions: Travel to Walhalla and continue north for approximately 10 mi. on Hwy 28 after its intersection with Hwy 11. Turn right onto Hwy 107. The park will be 2 miles further on the right.

We will be at the park's Group Camp Site: bear right as you drive into the park. The Group Camp Site shares a parking lot with the "Barn," to the right as you enter the camping area of the park. if we are away at one of the activities listed above, we will leave a note to let you know when we will return. You can go ahead and set up your tent either way.

Thursday, June 10 (after 2:00) through noon on Sunday, June 13. Or just come for an evening, day, etc.
